Scholarship Application

Jemez House, Inc., a non-profit organization, receives income from the Jemez House Thrift Store in White Rock, NM, contributions from individuals and interest from investments.

Jemez House offers limited scholarships, up to a maximum of \$4000 per year, to assist young people who have been resident clients of New Mexico group homes. A scholarship may be used by the recipient for support during education or vocational training at a recognized college or other educational institution, as a step toward self-sufficiency.

A scholarship is awarded for one year. It will be paid to the recipient, usually in monthly installments, after proof of admission and registration at the chosen institution. The scholarship will normally be continued in subsequent years, as long as the recipient remains in school.
